There has never been a better time for environmentalists to become vegetarians. Evidence of the environmental impacts of a meat-based diet is piling up at the same time its health effects are becoming better known. He is the “Conservation Works” columnist for *AMC Outdoors*, the “Autos and the Environment” columnist for the *Cleveland Plain Dealer*, and writes “Green Living” for the Environmental Defense newsletter. His writing on population won a 1999 Global Media Award from the Population Institute.
